## Job description

### Mission :

### Profile :

- University degree for teaching primary school level;
- Native speakers – DE, FR, EN, ES, LT, NL, SV, FI, PL, PT (mother tongue level or level C2);
- Previous experience as teacher in the primary school;
- Knowledge of any other vehicular language (EN, FR, DE) of the European School of Luxembourg is considered an asset;
- Motivated to work in a multilingual and multicultural environment;
- Ability to teach mixed classes with students at different levels of knowledge;
- Available on short notice;
- The candidate has to be an EU citizen or be “holder of an authorization to stay for a salaried worker” in Luxembourg.

### We offer :
