

Proposed S6 Students' Trip to Ireland

An Exciting Educational Journey Through Galway, the Aran Islands, Adventure Centre, and Dublin



Arrival in Dublin & Transfer to Galway

- Morning:
- Arrival at Dublin Airport.
- Private coach transfer to Galway (~2.5 hours).
- Afternoon:
- Check-in at a centrally-located hotel or hostel in Galway.
- Group lunch in Galway.
- Evening:
- Walking tour of Galway: Eyre Square, the Spanish Arch, and the Claddagh.
- Dinner
- Overnight in Galway.





Day Trip to the Aran Islands

- Early breakfast at the hotel.
- Transfer to Rossaveal port
- Ferry ride to Inis Mór (largest of the Aran Islands).
- Guided tour of Inis Mór by minibus or bicycles.
- Visit the prehistoric fort Dún Aonghasa.
- Explore local craft shops and island landscape.
- Return ferry and transfer back to Galway.
- Group dinner in Galway.
- Overnight in Galway.

Adventure Centre

- Morning:
- Early breakfast and check-out.
- Transfer to Adventure Centre Day:
- Full day of outdoor activities: zip-lining, kayaking/canoeing, high ropes, archery, and teambuilding exercises.
- Evening:
- Dinner



Transfer to Dublin

- Morning:
- Breakfast in Galway
- Departure to Dublin (~2.5 hours by bus).
- Lunch Check-in at a hotel or hostel in Dublin.
- Walking tour of Dublin/ Epic Musuem
- Free time to explore Dublin.
- Group dinner and overnight in Dublin.

Exploring and Airport

Breakfast at the hotel.

Epic Musuem if not covered the evening previously

Private coach transfer to Dublin Airport for departure.
